

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois has enacted "An Act regulating wages of laborers, mechanics and other workers employed in any public works by the State, county, city or any public body or any political subdivision or by any one under contract for public works," approved June 26, 1941, as amended, (820 ILCS 130/1 et. seq. as amended by Public Acts 86-799 and 86-693) and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid Act requires that the Memorial Park District, Cook County, Illinois investigate and ascertain the prevailing rate of wages as defined in and Act for laborers, mechanics and other works in the locality of said Memorial Park District employed in performing construction of public works, for said Park District.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF MEMORIAL PARK DISTRICT:

SECTION 1: To the extent and as required by "An Act regulating wages of laborers, mechanics and other works employed in any public works by State, county, city or any public body or any political subdivision or by any one under contract for public works," approved June 26, 1941, as amended, the general prevailing rate of wages in this locality for laborers, mechanics and other rate of wages in this locality for laborers, mechanics and other works engaged in construction of public works coming under the jurisdiction of the Memorial Park District is hereby ascertained to be the same as the most recent prevailing rate of wages for construction work in the Cook County area as determined by the construction work in the Cook County area as determined by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois, a copy of that determination (June 2017) being attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. As required by said Act, any and all revisions of the prevailing rate of wages by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois shall supersede the Department's June determination and apply to any and all public works construction undertaken by the Memorial Park District. The definition of any terms appearing in this Ordinance which are also used in aforesaid Act shall be the same as in said Act.

SECTION 2: Nothing herein contained shall be construed to apply said general prevailing rate of wages as herein ascertained to any work or employment except public works construction of the Memorial Park District to the extent required by the aforesaid act.

SECTION 3: The Memorial Park District Secretary shall publicly post or keep available for inspection by any interested party in the main office of the Memorial Park District this determination of any revision of such prevailing rate of wage. A copy of this determination or of the current revised determination of prevailing rate of wages then in effect shall be attached to all contraction specifications.


SECTION 4: The Memorial Park District secretary shall mail a copy of this determination to any employer, and to any association of employers and to any person or association of employees who have filed their names and addresses, requesting copies of any determination stating the particular rates and the particular class of workers whose wages will be affected by such rates.

SECTION 5: The Memorial Park District Secretary shall promptly file a certified copy of this Ordinance with the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois.

SECTION 6: The Memorial Park District Secretary shall cause to be published in a newspaper of general circulation within the constitute notice that the determination is effective and that this is the determination of this public body.


